INTERNET SAFETY RULES

- DON'T GIVE OUT OR POST ANY PERSONAL INFORMATION SUCH AS YOUR NAME, HOME ADDRESS, SCHOOL NAME, OR TELEPHONE NUMBER.
- DON'T POST PERSONAL INFORMATION ON YOUR SOCIAL NETWORKING PROFILE
- PICK A PASSWORD THAT IS HARD FOR OTHERS TO GUESS AND NEVER SHARE IT WITH ANYONE EXCEPT YOUR PARENTS.
- DO NOT PUT YOUR WEBCAM IN A PLACE THAT WOULD GIVE OUT ANY OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION
- IMMEDIATELY DELETE UNKNOWN E-MAIL ATTACHMENTS WITHOUT OPENING THEM
- IF ANYONE MAKES YOU FEEL UNCOMFORTABLE ONLINE, LEAVE THAT SITE & TELL AN ADULT

Social Networking Safety Tips

- Add only friends you know in real life
 - Set your profile to private
 - Use a nickname that doesn't identify your location, gender or age
 - Profile and photo share only with people on your friends list
 - Never post your plans or whereabouts
 - Ignore harassing and rude comments
 - Do not post embarrassing pictures of anyone
 - Never reply to text messages from people you don't know
